 - o Most calls that involve a citation for possession of marijuana or paraphernalia are calls specifically about marijuana use.

- Most offenders cited live in the dorm so that puts them in the 18-20 year old range, both male and female.
- Categorization based on whether the enforcement activity was conducted at the behest of or in coordination with county, state, or federal agencies.
 - The only incidents The UM Office of Public Safety work with any other agency on a drug call is when a felony drug case is generated. By memorandum of understanding those investigations are turned over to the drug enforcement group of city/county and federal agencies. There was 1 in 2006, 0 in 2007.
- Categorization based on whether property was seized.
 - 0 property seized except for illegal contraband.
